User Need	Interpreted Need
Architectural design that reflects who they are and their values. Must also include sustainability built into the design	Sustainable creative minimalist design. That represents eco friendliness, Pikwākanagān way of life, and circular features.
Lab with five to seven workspaces. Each workspace needs a computer as well as a moving table for plant processing.	Multifunctional computer lab workspace for up to seven people, with work tables .
Freezer for storing samples, and large enough for harvesting a deer	Includes a large freezer space, not a walk in freezer
A large table on wheels that can function as a mobile work station multifunctional	Part of the workstation is portable and can be brought throughout the building
Ideally, an outdoor multifunctional space for cultural activities Ex: Cleaning fish, moose hide tannings	Outdoor multifunctional space for different activities.
High level security measures, especially for parking lot	Include many security cameras throughout the perimeter and inside building
Medicine area with a drying station. (does not need actual sterilisation process)	Sterile station in Lab area with easily cleanable surfaces
dual parking with enough space and outdoors area	Parking enough for minimum two trucks (eg. Chevy Silverato)
Washroom (with at least two stalls) and Kitchenette	Washroom and Kitchen area for staff usage
Storage for snowmobiles in the summer(not mandatory)	Indoor parking garage
A parking lot for the trucks that connects to the loading dock	Parking lot with room accessible for trucks (eg. Chevy Silverato)
A lean-to off the side of building that a large truck could be parked under when not in use	A "Lean-to" structure on the side of the building that serves as a car roof. (Figure 1)
A loading dock that can load things into backs of vehicles.	Loading dock by parking lot
Storage for handheld equipments	Storage space for tools used
Common area, say a board-room area with team meetings, enough to have a good-sized room board table	Large common room for groups to gather around a table and work together
Accessibility features such as wheelchair ramps, accessible bathrooms, especially for elderly or special needs.	Ensure building has accessibility features available
Aspects of timber-build	Include timber from the community in the building
